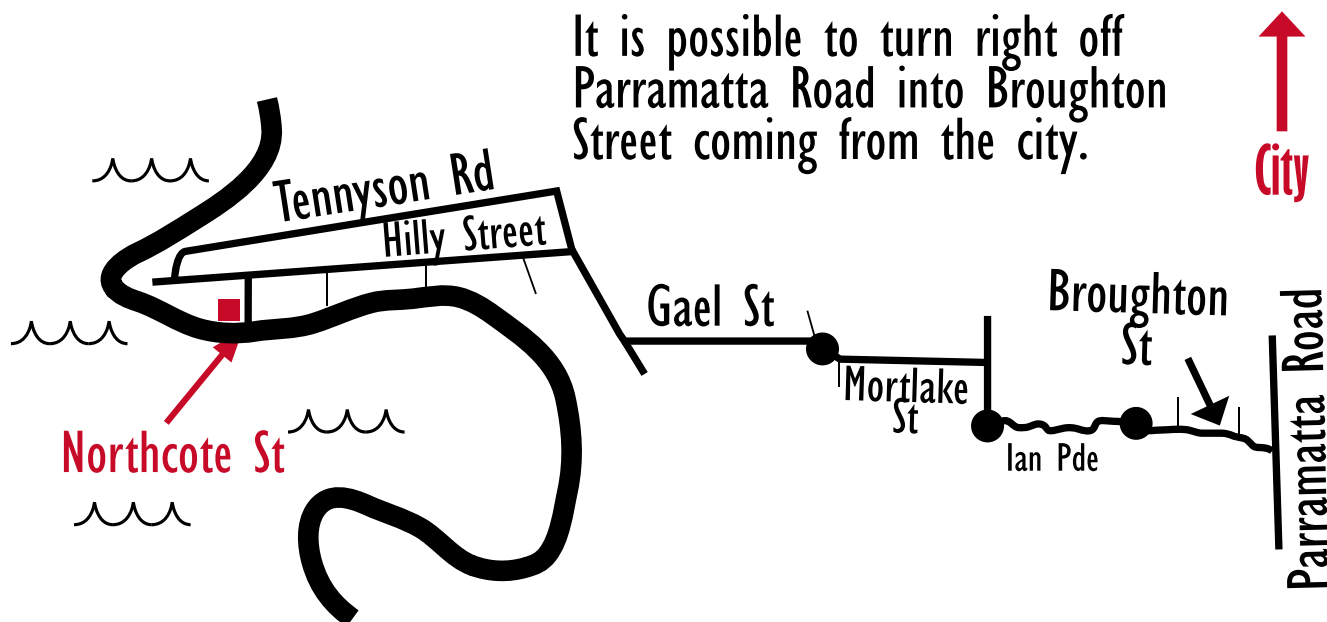

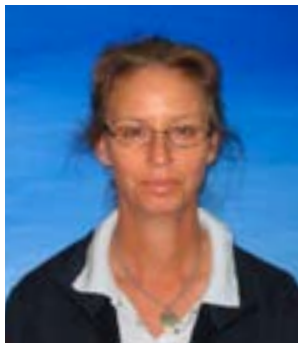

ChemTalk

We've been working very hard over the past 12 months to bring you more brilliant new colours. Here is a snapshot of some of the new colours in the range of Structure and Flow and I hope you enjoy painting with them as much as I have enjoyed making them!

- **Iso Yellow** – Very deep, red shade of yellow. Semi opaque.
- **Bismuth Yellow** – Bright, almost fluorescent green shade of yellow. Opaque.
- **Primary Yellow** – Mid shade yellow, ideal for mixing.
- **Primary Red** – Mid shade red, ideal for mixing.
- **Quinacridone Red** – Interesting balance of yellow and blue in this lovely red. Transparent.
- **Permanent Maroon** – Dark, blue shade red. Transparent.
- **Transparent Venetian Red** – Bluish shade deep red/brown. Transparent.
- **Transparent Red Oxide** – Yellow shade, red/brown. Transparent.
- **Transparent Yellow Oxide** – Beautiful, luminescent yellow oxide. Transparent.

- **Transparent Umber** – Mid shade brown with lovely dark mass tone. Transparent.
- **Primary Blue** – Greenish shade blue, ideal for mixing.
- **Cobalt Teal** – Beautiful blue/green shade of Cobalt. Opaque.
- **Australian Blue Gum** – Lovely, greyish green/blue. Opaque
- **Australian Salmon Gum** – Interesting, slightly greyish, yellow shade red. Opaque
- **Graphite Grey** – Dark grey, pure carbon. Interesting shimmer. Opaque.
- **Mars Grey and Carbon Grey** – Lovely mixtures of Mars and Carbon blacks. Opaque

Also, look out for the extension to the range of Structure colours that brings the ranges of Structure and Flow together.
